Further to your recent request I have now visited the above-mentioned site and can confirm that I have no objection to the proposed habitat restoration works and associated loss/removal of trees (willow). Whilst one would normally object to the loss of the larger willow, the proposed methodology and associated creation of the new wetland habitat within the Country Park is, in my opinion will provide a positive impact on the biodiversity and visual amenity of the site.

What I would ask is that an assessment of the potential impact of the positioning of the spoil, creating the bund at the rear of the wetland on the trees to be retained, together with the necessary tree protection is undertaken by a suitable experienced arboriculturalist prior to commencement of any permitted works.
